



**Plant Health Act**

REQUIREMENT TO DISPOSE OF  
BANANA AND PLANTAIN PLANTS  
LOT 03963, HUNDRED OF BAGOT

I, ANDREW ROBERT TOMKINS, Acting Chief Inspector of Plant Health, under section 20(1) of the *Plant Health Act*, for the control of Banana Freckle (*Phyllosticta cavendishii*) (the *declared pest*), require the owner of banana and plantain plants located on Lot 03963 Hundred of Bagot (the *property*) to treat and dispose of all banana and plantain plants on the property by allowing the Chief Inspector, inspectors of plant health and other persons authorised by the Chief Inspector for the purpose to:

- (a) enter onto the property and;
- (b) excavate all banana and plantain plants on the property; and
- (c) remove all banana and plantain plant material for quarantine disposal.

The reason for the decision to give this notice is because the property is affected by the declared pest and the owner has a right to apply under section 58 of the *Act* for reconsideration of the decision.
