Control of Roads Act

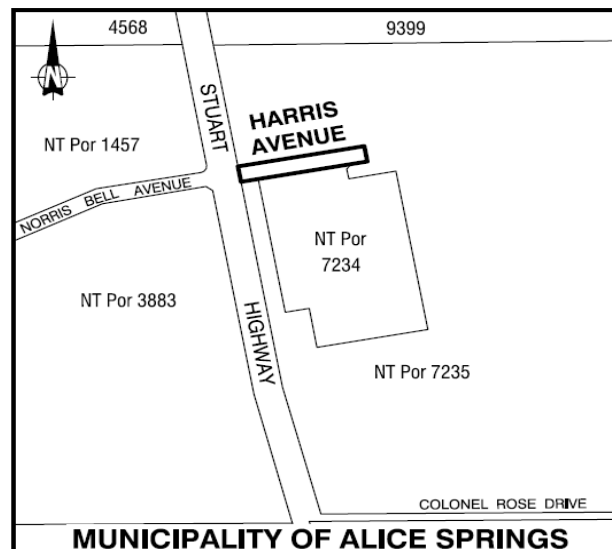
