

GOVE WATER CONTROL DISTRICT

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ALL THAT piece or parcel of land in the Northern Territory of Australia containing an area of 140 miles more or less; commencing at the most southerly point of the intersection of the meridian of east longitude 136 degrees 45 minutes with the coastline of Melville Bay; and bounded thence generally northerly and north-westerly by the coastline of Melville Bay to Dundas Point; thence generally north-easterly following the coastline of the Arafura Sea to Cape Wirawawoi; thence generally south-easterly by the coastline of the Arafura Sea to its intersection with the coastline of the Dalywoi Bay; thence generally south-westerly by the northern coastline of Dalywoi Bay and the northern coastline of the western arm of Dalywoi Bay to its south-western extremity; thence by a line due west to its intersection with the aforesaid meridian of east longitude 136 degrees 45 minutes; and thence north by the said meridian to the point of commencement.
