BUILDING NOTE

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SECTION 40 CERTIFICATES DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION

The Building Advisory Committee has approved the use of new engineering section 40 certificates of compliance for the hydraulic, mechanical and structural design of building work.

The purpose of these forms is to ensure all the relevant design information is captured, to enable informed decisions by the design engineer and other industries that may rely on the information.

New construction certificates for each category of engineering work have also been introduced.

The use of the forms will be effective from 1 May 2012. The existing forms for structural design and construction must not be used for any Section 40 Certificates issued after this date.
