Fisheries Regulations

Fees and Levies 2018–2019

I, Kenneth Edward Vowles, Minister for Primary Industry and Resources:

- (a) under regulation 206(1)(a) of the *Fisheries Regulations*, prescribe the fee payable for the grant or renewal of:
 - (i) a licence specified in Schedule 1, Part A, for the licensing year commencing on 1 July 2018 to be the amount specified opposite the licence; and
 - (ii) a licence specified in Schedule 1, Part B, for the licensing year commencing on 1 January 2019 to be the amount specified opposite the licence; and
- (b) under regulation 206(1)(aa) to (d) of the Regulations, prescribe the fee payable on and from 1 July 2018 for a matter mentioned in Schedule 2 to be the amount specified opposite the matter; and
- (c) under regulation 207(1) of the Regulations, prescribe for the licensing year commencing on 1 July 2018 or 1 January 2019:
 - (i) a levy of \$1 195 to be paid by an applicant for the grant or renewal of a Mud Crab Fishery licence; and
 - (ii) a levy of \$895 to be paid by an applicant for the grant or renewal of any other licence listed in Schedule 3 to the Regulations.
