Description of Activity:	The Dredger CSD Arnhem will be operating in the Darwin Ship Lift project area within the demarcation buoys, as described in Local NtM 2024 - 063.	
	A white flexible pipeline will extend from the dredger towards the shore, (see diagram below), which will have marker buoys with yellow lights (indicated by blue stars in diagram) displaying the warning sign on the buoy, "Caution Caution Submerged Pipeline".	
	This white pipeline will connect to an orange poly/steel pipeline that will be approximately 5-8m off the shore. The pipeline will comprising of 1070m of orange poly (800m) and steel pipe (270m), with a yellow light on buoy's placed every 200m along the pipeline. A flexible pipeline (green) will be circa 5 – 8 m from the shore to the discharge location.	
	The lights on all buoys will be yellow and have a sequence of 1 sec on / 3 secs off / 1 sec on.

- . The flexible hose (white) will have x3 lights (blue stars), with buoys
- · Buoys will be SL B700 with warning sign on the buoy, "Caution Caution Submerged Pipeline"
- Orange line represents 1070m of poly (800m) and steel pipe (270m)
- · This hose will be circa 5 to 8m from shore
- . There will be a light and a buoy every 200m along the orange pipeline, buoy is illustrated below
- A light will be on all the buoys (SL-15, specification attached) will have a sequence of 1 sec on/3
 secs off/ 1 sec on
- Green pipe will be flexible pipe up onto shore
- This will be placed through the culvert and under the road (length TBC)
