<b>Location of activity:</b>	Fort Hill Wharf (FHW)
<b>Assets/ Vessels involved</b>	None
<b>Description of Activity:</b>	<p>Duratec are undertaking fender maintenance work FHW, requiring hanging scaffold on the seaward side of the wharf.</p> <p>Vessels Operators are reminded of the offences under s.18 (4) and s.18 (6) (b) of the <i>NT Marine (General) Regulations 2013</i>, of navigating a vessel at a speed exceeding 5 knots within 100m of a jetty, wharf or commercial shipping and cargo area, and that causing excessive wash that endangers the safety of a person, boat or structure may also carry a penalty.</p> <p>To assist in maintaining the safety of the above maintenance work, it is requested all vessels keep 300m off the seaward face of FHW.</p>
