## Darwin Waterfront Harmony Soiree



The Soiree is scheduled for May every year. The exact event date for particular year will be communicated to all participants as soon as it's confirmed. The event runs between 4pm and 8:30pm and we're calling for more multicultural groups and their members to share this celebration of what Darwin is.

The Soiree provides a great opportunity for groups to showcase their culture and talent to the wider community, who will be enjoying this social event. There will be a large cross section of the Darwin population in attendance, so organisers are aiming to have as much interaction as possible in a relaxed picnic style atmosphere.

Multicultural groups are asked to start thinking about their participation now, and register an expression of interest if they wish to share a performance. Performances will be conducted on stage with professional sound and lighting supplied. Due to the number of groups who participate, a typical performance length is 5-8 minutes.

Any funding assistance required is to be sought through the Quick Response Grant using the Quick Response Grant Application – Darwin Waterfront Harmony Soiree.
