\$100 SPORT VOUCHER

Sport Voucher Activity Provider Fact Sheet

The Urban Sport Voucher model provides families with access to two \$100 sport vouchers each year to assist with the costs of getting children involved in after school and weekend sport, active recreation and cultural activities. One voucher is available in January and another in July.

Parents or carers apply for vouchers online each semester through their GrantsNT profile. To support families who are unable to access the online service, we encourage registered activity providers to help these families by assisting them access GrantsNT and apply for their voucher(s) online.

How parents apply

- 2. Click apply online
- 3. Follow the prompts to create your profile and request your vouchers.

Important dates

- 2021 online applications open 12 July 2021
- Applications close 24 May 2022
- All vouchers expire and should not be accepted by Activity Providers after 31 May 2022
- Providers must redeem vouchers in GrantsNT by 7 June 2022

Activity providers are required to register annually and historic approval does not guarantee future eligibility.

Activity providers can accept vouchers for music/instrumental lessons and swimming programs during school hours, however, vouchers must be redeemed by the registered Activity Provider and not the school.

Registered activity providers can accept vouchers for the following:

- Registration/membership fees
- Insurance fees
- Purchasing uniforms and equipment related to the program or activity being undertaken (when purchased through the same registered activity provider).
