

Permit to import soil, compost and potting mix application

This application applies to import of soil, compost and potting or soil and plant material for the purpose of diagnostic or laboratory testing, as authorised under regulation 25 of the *Plant Health Act 2008*. All applications must be received at least **five** working days prior to import.

Certain exemptions apply, including if the material is packaged or in bulk, and is either accompanied by a government certificate specifying it was manufactured in accordance with the requirements in the relevant Australian Standard, or was manufactured in accordance with the requirements in the relevant Australian Standard and is clearly labelled as such. The Australian Standard for compost is AS4454, and for potting mix is AS 3743. Contact plant biosecurity officers for further information.
