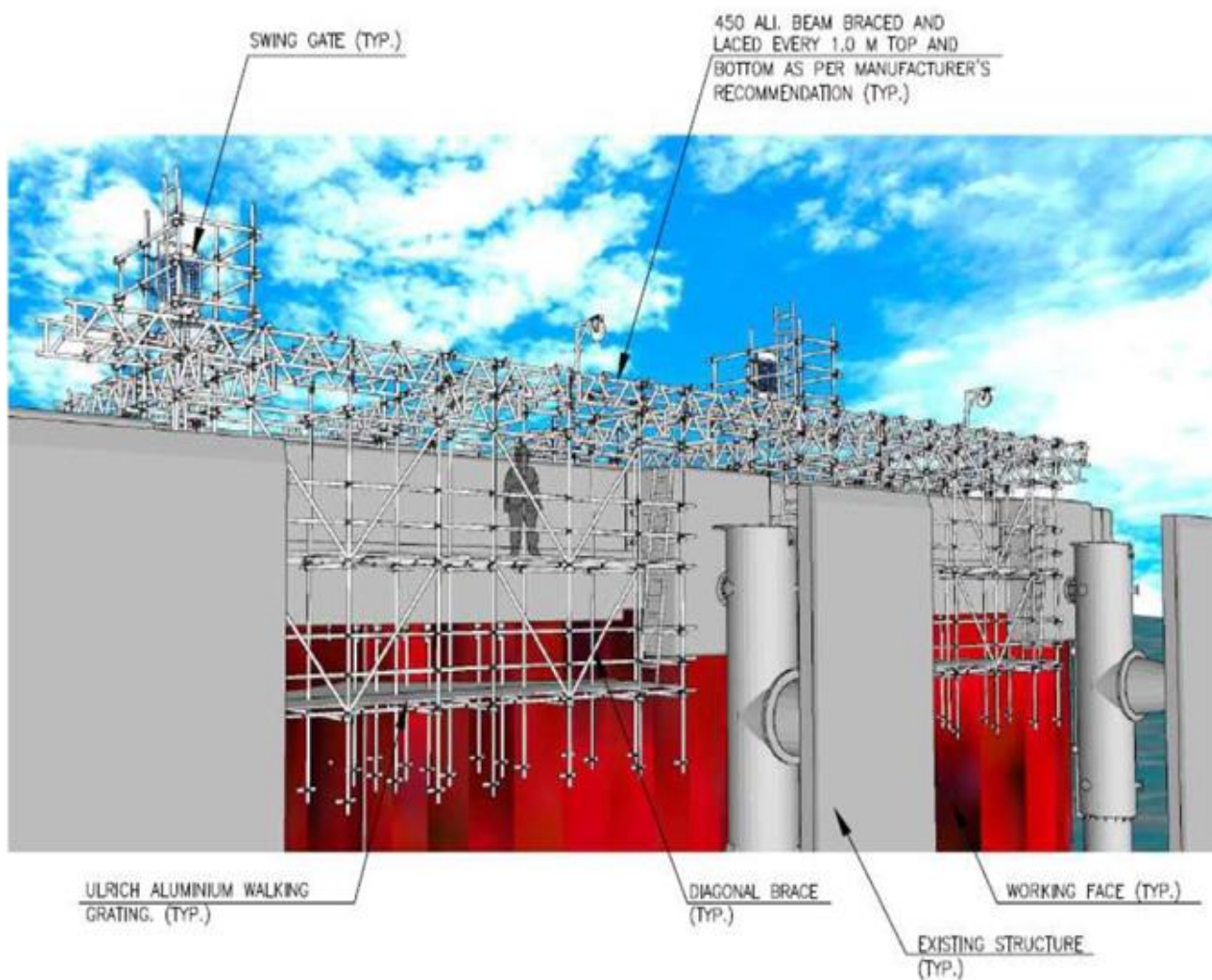

Description of Activity:	<p>The ILNG MOF is to undergo jetty sheet pile abrasive blasting and painting expected to take up to 5 - 6 months. This scope will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Surface preparation and coating of the sheet pile structure• Upgrade of the Cathodic Protection System• Refurbishment of the mooring / fendering system• Recertification <p>From mid - June through to late October 2024, scaffolding will be erected in sections along the MOF perimeter to gain access to the sheet pile structure.</p>
