# Declaration for Lawful Killing of Species of Protected Wildlife: Waterfowl, 2024 to 2025

- I, Kathryn Jane Worden, Minister for Environment, Climate Change and Water Security:
- (a) under section 45(1) of the Territory Parks and Wildlife Conservation Act 1976 (the Act) and with reference to section 43 of the Interpretation Act 1978, revoke the declaration made by the instrument entitled "Declaration for Lawful Killing of Species of Protected Wildlife: Waterfowl, 2023 to 2024" dated 28 August 2023 and notified in Gazette No. S63 of 30 August 2023; and
- (b) under section 45(1) of the Act and with reference to section 45(2) of the Act, declare that it is lawful to kill animals of each species of protected wildlife specified in the Schedule, Part A or B, subject to the conditions specified in the Schedule, Part C.

#### Part C

- An animal of a species of protected wildlife specified in Part A or B (the *designated species*) that is within an area of land that is not private land, may be killed by a person only during the period commencing on 25 September 2024 and ending on 6 January 2025 and between the following times:
  - (a) 6:00 am to 7:00 pm on each day in the period commencing on 25 September 2024 and ending on 31 October 2024;
  - (b) 5:50 am to 7:15 pm on each day in November 2024;
  - (c) 5:50 am to 7:30 pm on each day in the period commencing on 1 December 2024 and ending on 6 January 2025.

- 2 An animal of a designated species that is within an area of land that is private land, may be killed by a person:
  - (a) if the person is not the owner of the land with the prior permission of the owner of the land; and
  - (b) during the period commencing on 15 August 2024 and ending on6 January 2025 and between the following times:
    - (i) 6:30 am to 7:00 pm on each day in the period commencing on 15 August 2024 and ending on 31 August 2024;
    - (ii) 6:00 am to 7:00 pm on each day in September 2024 and October 2024;
    - (iii) 5:50 am to 7:15 pm on each day in November 2024;
    - (iv) 5:50 am to 7:30 pm on each day in the period commencing on 1 December 2024 and ending on 6 January 2025.
- The area within which an animal of a designated species may be killed is the whole of the Territory except for the following areas:
  - (a) a park, reserve, sanctuary or wilderness zone;
  - (b) any area where, under a law in force in the Territory, the discharging of a firearm, as defined in section 3(1) of the *Firearms Act 1997*, is prohibited.
- 4 An animal of a designated species may be killed only with the following type of equipment:
  - (a) a shotgun of not more than size 10 gauge and not less than size 20 gauge;
  - (b) if the animal is of a species of protected wildlife specified in Part A:
    - (i) shot cartridges containing non-toxic shot; and
    - (ii) if the shot is steel shot not smaller than size No. 2 and not larger than size BBB; and
    - (iii) if the shot is other than steel shot not smaller than No. 4 and not larger than size BBB;

- (c) if the animal is of a species of protected wildlife specified in Part B:
  - (i) shot cartridges containing non-toxic shot; and
  - (ii) if the shot is steel shot not smaller than size No. 6 and not larger than size BB; and
  - (iii) if the shot is other than steel shot not smaller than No. 6 and not larger than size No. 1;
- (d) a bow (excluding a crossbow) and arrow.
- 5 The maximum number of animals a person may kill each day is:
  - (a) 7 animals of the species of protected wildlife specified in Part A; and
  - (b) 10 animals in total of one or more of the species of protected wildlife specified in Part B.

#### Example for condition 5(b)

The maximum number of animals of a species of protected wildlife specified in Part B that a person may kill each day could comprise:

- (a) 10 Pacific Black Ducks; or
- (b) 4 Pacific Black Ducks, 3 Grey Teals and 3 Hardhead Ducks.
- The maximum number of dead animals or parts of dead animals a person may have in the person's possession or under the person's control is:
  - (a) if the person is at the person's place of residence unlimited; or
  - (b) if the person is not at the person's place of residence:
    - (i) 21 dead animals or parts of dead animals of the species specified in Part A; and
    - (ii) 30 dead animals or parts of dead animals in total of one or more species of protected wildlife specified in Part B.

#### Example for condition 6(b)(ii)

The maximum number of dead animals or parts of dead animals of a species of protected wildlife specified in Part B that a person may have in the person's possession or under the person's control, if the person is not at the person's place of residence, could comprise:

- (a) 30 Pacific Black Ducks; or
- (b) 10 Pacific Black Ducks, 10 Grey Teals and 10 Hardhead Ducks.
- 7 A person may only kill an animal of a designated species if the person:
  - (a) has been granted a permit to do so; or

- (b) is the nominee under a permit that has been granted to another person to do so.
- 8 A person must not do any of the following:
  - (a) use shot cartridges containing toxic shot to kill an animal of a designated species;
  - (b) kill an animal of a designated species for commercial purposes;
  - (c) kill an animal of a designated species except for the purpose of human consumption;
  - (d) kill an animal of a designated species unless the animal is fully fledged.

Example for condition 8(a)

A shot cartridge containing toxic shot could be the following:

- (a) lead shot;
- (b) coated lead shot;
- (c) zinc shot.

Note for condition 8(b)

The term commercial purpose is defined in section 9(1) of the Act.

- 9 A person:
  - (a) must take reasonable steps to retrieve the animals that the person has killed; and
  - (b) may use decoys; and
  - (c) may use retriever dogs to locate or flush the animals or retrieve dead animals.

### **Determination of Maximum Fares and Charges for Taxis**

- I, Joel Francis Bowden, Minister for Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics, with effect on and from 31 July 2024:
- (a) under section 26(1) of the Commercial Passenger (Road) Transport Act 1991 and with reference to section 43 of the Interpretation Act 1978, revoke the instrument titled "Determination of Maximum Fares and Charges for Taxis" dated 19 June 2023 and published in Gazette No. G15 on 20 July 2023; and
- (b) under section 26(1) of the Commercial Passenger (Road) Transport Act 1991, determine that the maximum fares and charges that may be charged for the hire or use of a taxi are as set out in the Schedule.

#### **Schedule**

#### Part 1 Definitions

1 In this Schedule:

**Alice Springs taxi area** means the area specified as such in a declaration as in force from time to time under section 16 of the Act.

applicable area, for Part 2, see clause 2.

airport exit toll means the amount charged by an airport for use of an airport taxi rank queuing facilities and/or waiting bays.

**core period** means the period starting from 6 am and ending immediately before 6 pm.

**Darwin taxi area** means the area specified as such in a declaration as in force from time to time under section 16 of the Act.

**distance rate** means the rate expressed in dollars per kilometre that may be charged for the distance travelled for a journey.

flagfall means the hire charge for a journey.

**Gove taxi area** means the area specified as such in a declaration as in force from time to time under section 16 of the Act.

high occupancy rate means the rate that applies as specified by clause 3.

**Katherine taxi area** means the area specified as such in a declaration as in force from time to time under section 16 of the Act.

**special journey** means a journey for a wedding, funeral or other special occasion where the hiring includes waiting until the wedding, funeral or other special occasion has taken place and further carriage of the hirer immediately afterwards.

**Tariff 1**, for an applicable area, means an amount specified in the table for that area for a journey:

- (a) made wholly within that area; and
- (b) starting on a weekday within the core period; and
- (c) in relation to which a high occupancy rate does not apply.

**Tariff 2**, for an applicable area, means an amount specified in the table for that area for a journey:

- (a) made partly within that area that starts at any time on any day, or made wholly within that area that starts:
  - (i) on a day other than a weekday; or
  - (ii) during a weekday outside the core period; and
- (b) in relation to which a high occupancy rate does not apply.

**Tariff 3**, for an applicable area, means an amount specified in the table for that area for a journey:

- (a) made wholly within that area; and
- (b) starting on a weekday within the core period; and
- (c) in relation to which a high occupancy rate applies.

**Tariff 4**, for an applicable area, means an amount specified in the table for that area for a journey:

- (a) made partly within that area that starts at any time on any day, or made wholly within that area that starts:
  - (i) on a day other than a weekday; or
  - (ii) during a weekday outside the core period; and
- (b) in relation to which a high occupancy rate applies.

**Tennant Creek taxi area** means the area specified as such in a declaration as in force from time to time under section 16 of the Act.

**waiting time** means a number of seconds of waiting time that must elapse before a charge of 10 cents may be made for a journey.

weekday means any day other than Saturday, Sunday or a public holiday.

# Part 2 Maximum fares and charges for taxi areas other than Tennant Creek taxi area

- This Part applies to the Alice Springs taxi area, Darwin taxi area, Gove taxi area and Katherine taxi area (each of which is an *applicable area*).
- A high occupancy rate applies only in relation to a journey for carriage of 5 or more passengers in a taxi licensed to carry 5 or more passengers (excluding the driver).
- 4 Subject to clauses 5 and 6, the maximum fare or charge that may be charged for the hire or use of a taxi for a journey made wholly or partly within an applicable area is the sum of:

- (a) the amounts calculated in accordance with the applicable tariff in the table for that area for the flagfall, distance rate and waiting time, for so much of the journey as is made within that area; and
- (b) any applicable airport exit toll.
- If the journey is a special journey made wholly or partly within the Gove taxi area, the maximum fare or charge that may be charged for the hire or use of the taxi for so much of the journey as is made within that taxi area is as follows:
  - (a) if the duration of the journey is one hour or less \$60.60;
  - (b) if the duration of the journey is more than one hour:
    - (i) for the first hour \$60.60; and
    - (ii) for each hour or part of an hour after the first hour \$29.00.
- If a taxi is soiled by a passenger in the course of a journey, the maximum amount that may be charged for the cost of cleaning the taxi is \$50.

#### Part 3 Maximum fares and charges for Tennant Creek taxi area

- 7 This Part applies only to the Tennant Creek taxi area.
- 8 Subject to clauses 9 and 10, the maximum fare or charge that may be charged for the hire or use of a taxi is:
  - (a) for a journey made wholly within the Tennant Creek taxi area \$11.10; or
  - (b) for a journey made partly within the Tennant Creek taxi area the sum of:
    - (i) the amounts calculated in accordance with Table 5 for the flagfall, distance rate and waiting time, for so much of the journey as is made within that area; and
    - (ii) any applicable airport exit toll.
- If the journey is a special journey made wholly or partly within the Tennant Creek taxi area, the maximum fare or charge that may be charged for the hire or use of the taxi for so much of the journey as is made within that taxi area is as follows:
  - (a) if the duration of the journey is one hour or less \$58.90; and

- (b) if the duration of the journey is more than one hour:
  - (i) for the first hour \$58.90; and
  - (ii) for each hour or part of an hour after the first hour \$28.80.
- 10 If a taxi is soiled by a passenger in the course of a journey, the maximum amount that maybe charged for the cost of cleaning the taxi is \$50.
