Regional Harbourmaster's Notice

Section 43, *Ports Management Act 2015*

Written Notice to the Owner of the white hulled yacht 'Runaway' presently sunk in Sadgroves Creek.

The Regional Harbour Master (RHM) considers the yacht, 'Runaway' presently sunk in Sadgroves Creek, Darwin presents a threat or danger to persons, other vessels and property within the Port of Darwin, and the environment.

Accordingly, the RHM directs the owner of the yacht 'Runaway' to take one or more of the following preventative actions within 14 days of the date of this notice:

- Remove it from the designated port.
- move it to another place within the port.
- Repair it and make it safe
- destroy it and all fittings and equipment onboard.

If the owner fails to comply with this direction within 14 days of the date of this notice, the RHM may, at the owner's cost, depending on the vessel condition, do one or more of the following with the vessel:

- a) remove it from the designated port.
- b) move it to another place within the port.
- c) repair and make it safe.
- d) destroy it and all fittings and equipment on board; or
- e) sell or otherwise dispose of it, and all fittings and equipment on board.
