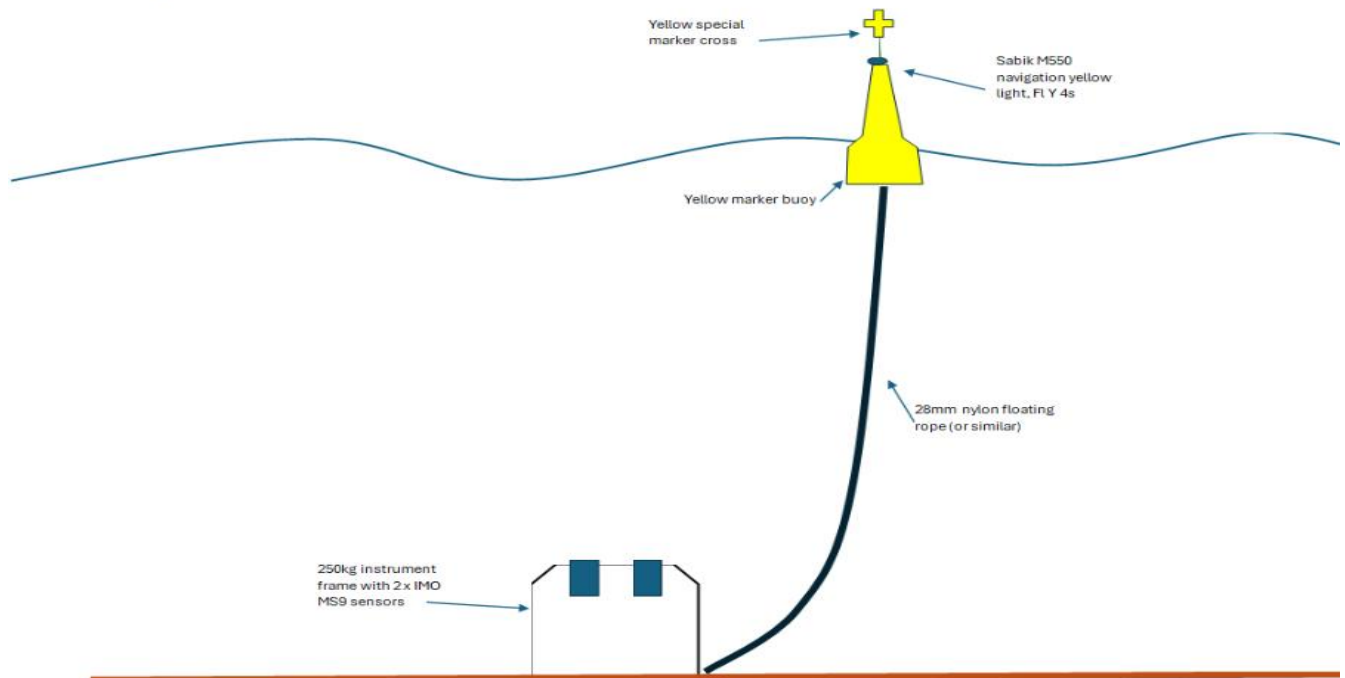
Port Users are notified the Water Quality Monitoring Systems in place in Darwin Harbour since November 2024 are to remain until January 2027.
