## **Regional Harbourmaster's Direction**

Section 40 B and 43, *Ports Management Act 2015*

### **Notice to the Sailing Vessel 'Rebel', presently illegally occupying private Mooring SG P 016 in Sadgroves Creek.**

Due to its condition the Acting Regional Harbour Master (A / RHM) considered the sailing vessel, 'Rebel' that was illegally occupying private Mooring SG P 016 in Sadgroves Creek, presented an immediate threat to other vessels, the environment, property and persons within the Port of Darwin.

Accordingly, the A / RHM has removed the yacht 'Rebel' off private mooring SG P 016 to an anchorage in Position 12° 26.689' S. 130° 51.672 E, where the owner, master and / or occupier remain responsible for the vessel.

The owner of the yacht 'Rebel' now has 28 days to take any of the actions listed below:

- Remove it from the designated port.
- move it to another place within the port.
- Repair it and make it safe
- destroy it and all fittings and equipment onboard.

If the owner fails to comply with this direction within 28 days of the date of this notice, the RHM may, at the owner's cost, due to the vessels condition destroy the vessel and all fittings and equipment on board
