The Department of Primary Industry and Resources (DPIR) is seeking information from you for the purposes of assessing your application under section 5 of the *Energy Pipelines Act* (the Act). This information will be kept confidential except as required by law.

DPIR is required to keep a register of Petroleum titles under section 44 of the Act. The information contained in this register includes the details of all applications for petroleum titles, specifying the name of each permittee or licensee, the term of the petroleum title and an accurate description of the land the subject of the petroleum title. Any person may obtain copies of this information under section 54 of the Act, on payment of the prescribed fee.
