DECLARATION OF OPEN AREAS

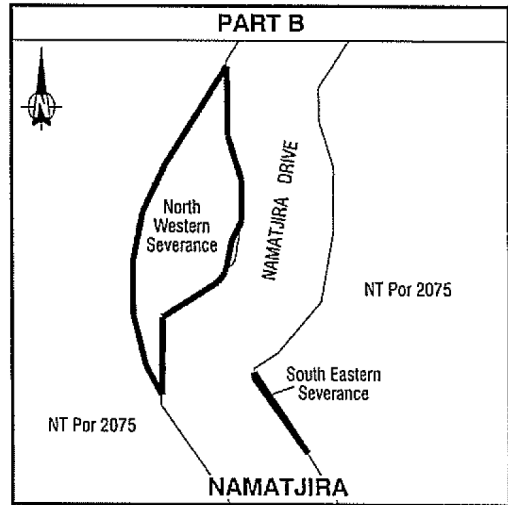

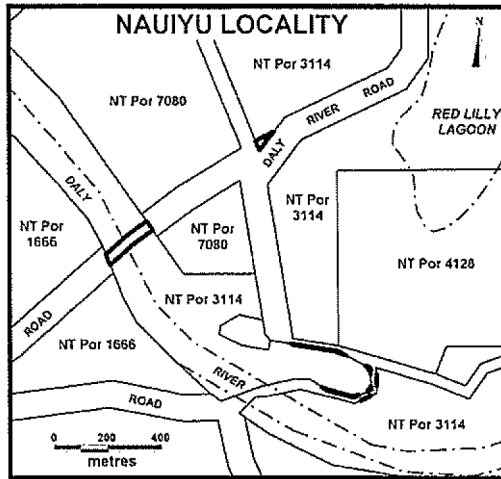
