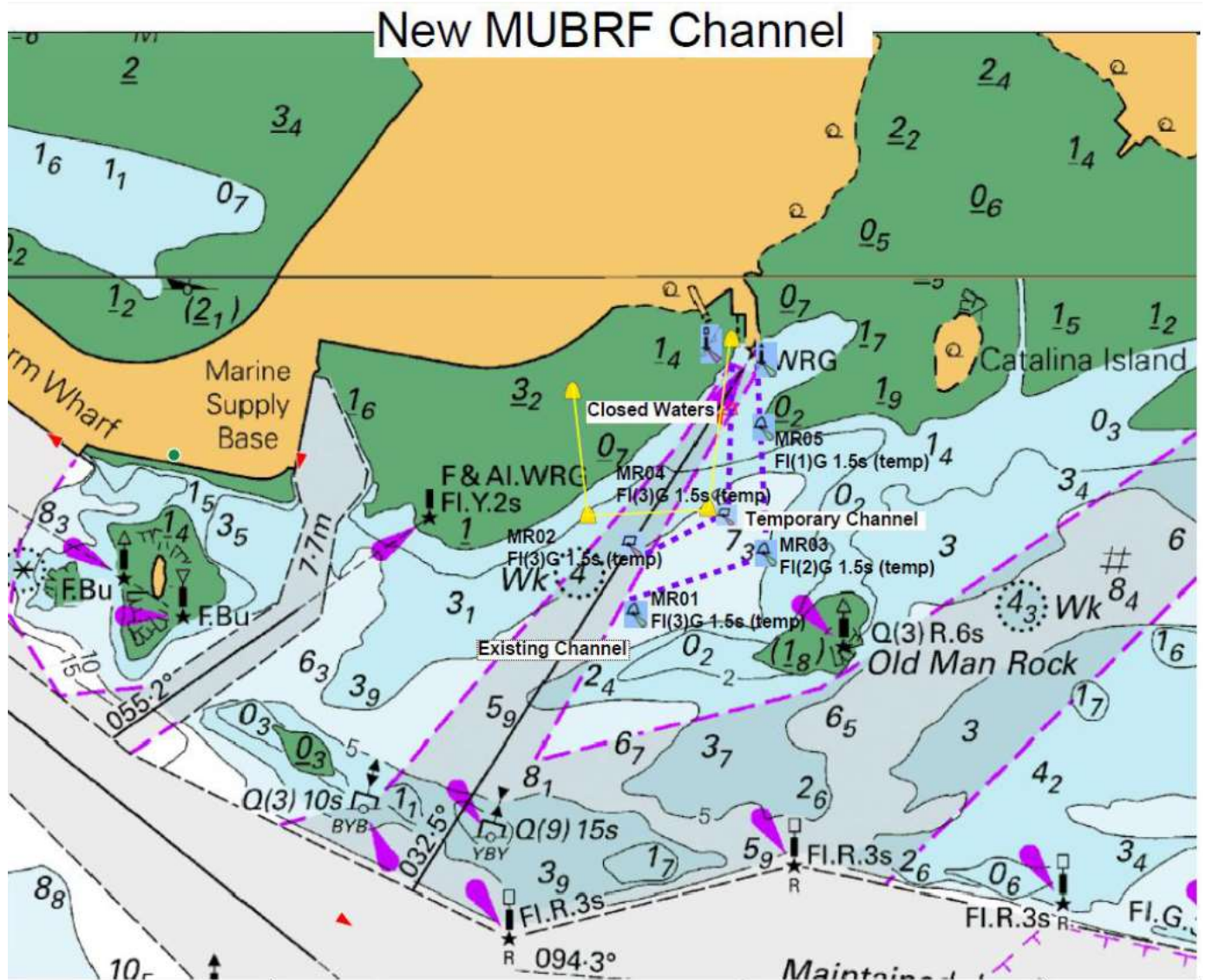

Description of Activity:	<p>The RHM has Closed Waters within the boundary delineated by four yellow marker buoys located in the following positions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• CW01 – 12° 29.501' S, 130° 53.749' E – FI (1) W3s (temp)• CW02 – 12° 29.737' S, 130° 53.805' E – FI (1) W3s (temp)• CW03 – 12° 29.692' S, 130° 54.028' E – FI (1) W3s (temp)• CW04 – 12° 29.402' S, 130° 54.059' E – FI (1) W3s (temp) <p>The temporary MUBRF channel is near the Closed Water. The Closed Water and the new MUBRF Channel is shown on the attached sketch.</p> <p>Vessel Masters are advised that entry into or transit through waters within the Closed Waters zone is prohibited to all persons and vessels, except those engaged in the dredging of the Darwin Ship-lift and vessels under the control of Darwin Port, the Regional Harbourmaster, or the NT Police.</p>
