



Territory Parks and Wildlife Conservation Act

DECLARATION OF PARK

I, THOMAS IAN PAULING, Administrator of the Northern Territory of Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive Council:

- (a) under section 12(1)(a) of the *Territory Parks and Wildlife Conservation Act*, declare the area of land described in the Schedule to be a park; and
- (b) under section 12(1)(aa) of the *Act*, declare that all right, title and interest held by the Territory in respect of that land does not vest in the Corporation; and
- (c) under section 17(5) of the *Act*, approve the Commission performing its functions in the park declared by paragraph (a) for the purpose of operating the park while a plan of management is being prepared for the park.

SCHEDULE

All of the land comprised in:

- (a) the whole of Northern Territory Portion 4386 as delineated on Survey Plans S2005/21A and B, being 111 900 ha more or less; and
- (b) that part of Northern Territory Portion 3977 as delineated on Survey Plan S2007/8 enclosed by the boundaries of Northern Territory Portion 4386 and the Epenarra - Murray Downs Road, being 15 810 ha more or less and held by the Anurrete Aboriginal Land Trust.
