That the swimming pool/spa on the premises noted above meets the Community Safety Standard in accordance with section 11 of the Swimming Pool Safety Act. 6. That the swimming pool/spa enclosure is designed, sited, constructed and maintained in a way that prevents (to the extent that is practicable and reasonable in all the circumstances) a child from gaining unsupervised access to the swimming pool/spa (Section 11(1)(a)). 7. That access to the swimming pool/spa is not prevented only by a perimeter boundary (Section 11(2)). 8. That the swimming pool/spa enclosure is of the type and height as specified in the sketch in Part 5 of this form, including whether windows and or doors form part of the barrier. 9. I / We \* have /have not received the advice of a Pool Safety Adviser that \*did/did not include an inspection of the swimming pool/spa enclosure. 10. If the dividing barrier of your property is being used as part of the enclosure for the swimming pool/spa, a Dividing Barrier Notice (form A1) must be given to the owner of each relevant adjoining premise before making this declaration. ## 5 Sketch of pool and barrier Note: Sketch does not need to be drawn to scale

You must specify each of the following on the sketch-

- 1. Type and height of fence specified e.g. tubular, chainmesh, vertical slat, rendered block work.
- 2. Location of pool and barrier to dwelling
- 3. Dividing barrier(s) with neighbouring properties (if any).
- 4. Gates: Latch heights, if selfclosing/self-latching and opening direction.
- 5. Doors: [refer to requirements for gates]
- 6. Windows that form part of the barrier: If security screened and type of screen.
