Statement
<p>I wish to be excluded from the above mentioned Sports Bookmaker/Betting Exchange Operator, and the identified wagering products, in accordance with the NT Code of Practice for Responsible Online Gambling 2016.</p> <p>In making this Self-Exclusion Notice, I acknowledge and accept the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. I am not to seek to wager or attempt to wager with the abovementioned Sports Bookmaker/Betting Exchange Operator, or on the identified gambling products for the Exclusion Period. This includes access via websites, mobile apps and telephone wagering.</li> <li>2. The Sports Bookmaker/Betting Exchange Operator may restrict my access to their websites, mobile apps and telephone wagering relating to their gambling products and services.</li> <li>3. My personal details, including the Exclusion Period provided for in this Notice, will be placed on the Responsible Gambling Incident Register held by the Sports Bookmaker/Betting Exchange Operator.</li> <li>4. Where I have sought exclusion from a Sports Bookmaker/Betting Exchange Operator completely, the Sports Bookmaker/Betting Exchange Operator will not allow me, or anyone else on my behalf, for the Exclusion Period, to access gambling products or services via any account(s) I have with the Sports Bookmaker/Betting Exchange Operator and the Sports Bookmaker/Betting Exchange Operator may close any such account(s).</li> <li>5. Where I have sought exclusion from particular wagering products with a Sports Bookmaker/Betting Exchange Operator, the Sports Bookmaker/Betting Exchange Operator will not allow me, or anyone else on my behalf, to access those gambling products and services via any account(s) I have with the Sports Bookmaker/Betting Exchange Operator, for the Exclusion Period.</li> <li>6. My exclusion from the gambling products and services of the abovementioned Sports Bookmaker/Betting Exchange Operator is voluntary and the only obligation, duty or responsibility of the Sports Bookmaker/Betting Exchange Operator, or any other person or body, is that which is required by law.</li> <li>7. I am aware that while the Sports Bookmaker/Betting Exchange Operator should use all reasonable means to enforce this self-exclusion agreement, the onus is on myself to comply with the terms I have agreed to.</li> <li>8. I am aware that in the instance that I have applied for self-exclusion from all Sports Bookmaker/Betting Exchange Operator licensed in the Northern Territory, the Regulator will endeavour to provide this Self-Exclusion Notice to any new Sports Bookmaker/Betting Exchange Operator who becomes licensed after lodgement of this form.</li> <li>9. I have the right to seek independent legal or other professional advice before signing and lodging this Notice.</li> </ol>
