I, Dinesh Kumar Arya, Chief Health Officer:

- (a) under section 252 of the *Medicines, Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act*, declare the clinic specified in the Schedule, Part A, to be a place to which Part 2.6 of the Act applies; and
- (b) under section 254(1) of the Act, approve each Scheduled substance treatment protocol specified in the Schedule, Part B, for the clinic specified in the Schedule, Part A; and
- (c) under section 250(1)(a) of the Act, declare each nurse practising at the clinic specified in the Schedule, Part A, who has the qualifications specified in the Schedule, Part C, to be an approved nurse to supply, administer to another person and possess the Schedule 4 substances specified in the Schedule, Part D, in accordance with each Scheduled substance treatment protocol specified in the Schedule, Part B.
