Documents submitted to support this statutory declaration are:

- R11 – Application to register/transfer a vehicle in the NT
- Evaluation certificate/letter from an Independent Valuer
- Invoices or receipts for parts, labour, maintenance, storage or transport of vehicle
- Any other documents that provide a direct link to any services provided in connection with the vehicle
- Written notice to the owner; of intention to sell the vehicle
- PPSR report/certificate – under section 19 of the *Uncollected Goods Act*
- Court order

Stamp duty is calculated at a rate of \$3 per \$100, or part thereof.
