

Affidavit - liquor application

To support an application made under the Liquor Act 2019.

Before you sign your affidavit

This document is designed to help you prepare your affidavit – do not rely on it as a template.

The onus is on you to make sure that enough information is included and attached for the decision-maker to make a decision about your application.

You must sign each page of your affidavit straight away in the presence of an authorised person. An authorised person includes a justice of the peace or a commissioner for oaths. You must say orally on oath, or affirm in front of the authorised person, that you are the person making the affidavit, that the contents are true and that the signature is yours.

Privacy statement

For the applicant:

We may share your information with the Liquor Commission, NT Police, Fire and Emergency Services, local council, the Department of Health and/or other authorities or people, but only if we are required or authorised by law to do so. We will also not use your personal information unless that use is required or authorised by law.
