1. Citation

This amendment to the NT Planning Scheme may be cited as Amendment No. 501.

2. Definition


In this amendment -

"amending map" means the map, signed by the Minister for Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics and marked "NT Planning Scheme Amendment No. 501", deposited in the office of the Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics, Darwin;

"zoning map" means the zoning map within the meaning of the NT Planning Scheme.

3. Amendment of Zoning Map

The NT Planning Scheme is amended by amending the zoning map relating to Darwin and East Arm to the extent of its inconsistency with the amending map in respect of the area of land shown on the amending map bounded by a thick black line and lettered DV which is part of Sections 7146 and 7147, Hundred of Bagot.

Reasons for Decision

NORTHERN TERRITORY PLANNING SCHEME AMENDMENT No. 501

Part sections 7146 and 7147, Hundred of Bagot (825 and 845 Berrimah Road, East Arm) are suitable for rezoning from Zone PM (Proposed Main Road) to Zone DV (Development).

Specifically, this rezoning is suitable because the identified road connection between East Arm and Middle Arm is no longer required under the Darwin Regional Land Use Plan (DRLUP).

The unused road corridor impedes on a proposed 14 lot industrial subdivision that will provide land for supporting industry around major marine projects. Rezoning the redundant road corridor to Zone DV (Development) will allow for Sections 7146 and 7147 Hundred of Bagot to be fully utilised for their intended use under the DRLUP, which envisages the development of this land for marine and logistic industries with proximity to East Arm Wharf and the Darwin to Adelaide freight terminal.

The application was put on exhibition in accordance with the requirements of the *Planning Act* and no public submissions were received.
