Fisheries Regulations 1992

Fees and Levies

I, Nicole Susan Manison, Minister for Agribusiness and Aquaculture:

- (a) under regulation 206(1)(a) of the *Fisheries Regulations 1992*, prescribe the fee payable on and from the date this instrument is published in the *Gazette* for the grant of a licence specified in Schedule 1 to be the amount specified opposite the licence; and
- (b) under regulation 206(1)(aa) to (e) of the Regulations and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act 1978*, revoke the prescription of fees made by paragraph (b) of the notice entitled "Fees and Levies 2019–2020" dated 30 May 2019 and published in *Gazette* No. S40 of 3 June 2019; and
- (c) under regulation 206(1)(aa) to (ea) of the Regulations, prescribe the fee payable on and from the date of this instrument is published in the *Gazette* for a matter mentioned in Schedule 2 to be the amount specified opposite the matter; and

- (d) under regulation 206(1A) of the Regulations, prescribe the method of assessing the fee payable on and from the date this instrument is published in the *Gazette* for a person to examine or obtain a copy of information from a register mentioned in section 9(2) of the *Fisheries Act 1988* to be the method set out in Schedule 3; and
- (e) under regulation 207(1) of the Regulations, prescribe:
- (i) a levy of \$733 to be paid by an applicant on and from the date this instrument is published in the *Gazette* for the renewal of a Mud Crab Fishery licence; and
 - (ii) a levy of \$583 to be paid by an applicant on and from the 1 January 2021 for the grant or renewal of a Pearl Oyster Fishery licence; and
 - (iii) a levy of \$583 to be paid by an applicant on and from the date this instrument is published in the *Gazette* for the grant or renewal of any other licence listed in Schedule 3 of the Regulations.
