Traffic Act 1987

Approval of a Helmet for the Rider of, or a Passenger on, a Motor Bike

I, Simon Phillip Saunders, Registrar of Motor Vehicles, under regulation 86B(1) of the *Traffic Regulations* 1999, for the purpose of rule 270(3) of Schedule 3 to the *Traffic Regulations* 1999 - the *Australian Road Rules*:

Approval of additional motor bike helmets

(a) approve a helmet that is made in compliance with the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe Regulation No. 22.06 – *Uniform provisions concerning the approval of protective helmets and of their visors for drivers and passengers of motor cycles and mopeds*;

(b) approve a helmet that is made in compliance with any later version of the regulation referred to in paragraph (a) above; and

Revocation of prior approvals

(c) with reference to repealed regulation 8(1)(b) of the *Traffic Regulations 1999* and section 43 of the *Interpretation Act 1978*, revoke the approval made in the instrument titled "Approval of Helmets for use by Persons on Motor Cycles", dated 4 September 2015 and published in *Gazette* No. G37 on 16 September 2015.

Note

An approved motor bike helmet also means a helmet which complies with the standards set out in rule 270(3) of Schedule 3 of the Traffic Regulations 1999 – the Australian Road Rules.
