

Litchfield National Park



Environmental Education Campground

Situated in the northern section of Litchfield National Park the campground provides camping areas, communal kitchen and shelter, and toilet and shower facilities. The Litchfield National Park Environmental Education Campground is available for use by schools, youth groups and other community organisations.

Bookings are Essential.

All education facility camping areas in Northern Territory Parks are booked online - nt.gov.au/park-bookings

You will need to create your Schools / Group account first, then search for Litchfield National Park and proceed to select the Environmental Education Campground.

Select your dates, confirm availability and book and pay - credit card required.

Before your visit contact the Litchfield Rangers at Batchelor to arrange access.

Fees

Category A - Adults are \$10.00 per night, children aged 5-17 years are \$5.00 per night, under 5's are free. All bookings must be paid in advance.

Conditions of Use

- Groups are limited to 40 persons, including adults.
- Please reduce noise after 9pm.
- School groups are asked to separate and bag recyclable and non-recyclable rubbish and dispose of it at recycling depots outside the Park.
- Environmental Education Campground to be kept neat and tidy at all times
- To keep the creek banks strong, use the water entry points
- Stay on track and paths
- All plants and animals are protected. Look, photograph or sketch but don't pick or disturb them or take them out of the Park.
- Keep animals wild, don't feed fish, birds, bandicoots or any other animals
- Use firewood provided. Collection of wood around the camping area is not permitted
- Fire is restricted to the designated campfire area - no separate fires please and make sure

they are out before you leave.

Facilities include:

- Large Communal Shelter with Kitchen and store room
- Kitchen includes gas stove, grill, 220L gas fridge, ample preparation area and sinks
- Separate ablution block including disabled toilet, hot showers and change area
- Large grass camping area
- Gas barbeques (please advise Rangers if needed before your stay)
- Large campfire area with 5 log bench seats. You must bring your own firewood with you, firewood is not to be collected from the park.
- Grassed camping area suitable for approximately 20, 2 person style tents
- Large turning area and parking for buses
- Solar electricity to run fans and lights, for any other requirements, please contact the Rangers
- Tables and trestles are available.
- Gas and water, cold and solar hot
- Picnic tables
- Large shade / rain shelter.

Discover ways to explore the Park:

- Bushwalking through the woodlands, sandstone rangers and monsoon forests, (day trails and overnight walks).
- Explore the freshwater river systems and swamp habitats.
- Swimming in designated areas (check signage for details and any closures).
