The Parks and Wildlife Commission of the Northern Territory in pursuance of section 14(2) of the *Territory*

Parks and Wildlife Conservation Act (TPWCA), gives notice that –

- (a) a report has been prepared regarding the declaration of Territorial waters from the mean low water mark and extending three nautical miles to the limit of Territory waters:
 - (i) surrounding Maria Island; and
 - (ii) adjacent to the Marra Land Trust and Nathan River (NT Portion 1334) from the southern entrance of the mouth of the Roper River, in a straight line to the edge of the mean low tide on the northern bank of the Roper River and thence to the limit of Territorial waters; and south to intersect a direct line from the mouth of Wuraliwuntya Creek to the limit of Territorial waters.

- (b) interested persons are invited to make representations in connection with the report within 60 days of this publication;
