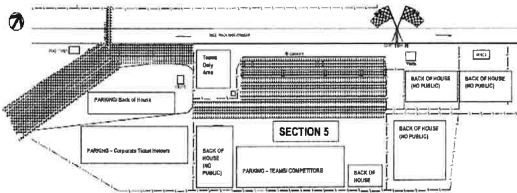
Hidden Valley Raceway –
