Northern Territory Government

Completing a Waybill is compulsory whenever cattle, buffalo, sheep, goats, camelid (camels, alpacas, llamas), deer and pigs are moved outside the boundaries of a property.

DEPARTMENT OF PRIMARY INDUSTRY AND FISHERIES

THE OWNER

The owner is responsible for completing these parts of the waybill.

Penalties apply if the waybill is not completed in full.

THE INSPECTOR OF STOCK

The Regional Livestock Biosecurity Officer is responsible for completing this section if a treatment is required for movement.

THE TRUCK DRIVER

The truck driver is responsible for completing these parts of the Waybill.

The truck driver must also complete the unloading details prior to handing the Waybill to the owner at the destination.
