1 Title

This instrument may be cited as the Residential Tenancies COVID-19 Modification Notice Amendment 2020.

12A Inspection of premises for sale

- (1) The landlord, or a person authorised by the landlord, may enter the premises or ancillary property to inspect them and prepare reports for purposes related to the sale of the premises or ancillary property if the entry is made:
 - (a) at a time agreed between the landlord and the tenant; and

- (b) at a time of which the tenant was given not less than 48 hours prior written or oral notice.
- (2) The landlord, or a person authorised by the landlord, may enter the premises or ancillary property for the purpose specified in subsection (1) of this section on no more than 2 occasions each week.

In section 99 of the Act, a reference to undue hardship includes:

- (a) financial hardship; and
- (b) risk to physical, psychological or mental health and safety.

Example for section 28(b)

A risk of domestic or family violence.
