## Notice of Closed Waters at East Arm Wharf

### Notification

Port Users are advised that pursuant to subsection 50 (1) of the *Ports Management Act 2015 (NT)*, the Darwin Port is closing the waters surrounding berth No. 1 at East Arm Wharf (EAW) due to a joint USN and ADF operation.

<b>Time &amp; Date of activity:</b>	14:00 hours Monday 24 March 2025 to 10:00 hours Thursday 3 April 2025
<b>Location of activity:</b>	East Arm Wharf
<b>Description of Activity:</b>	<p>The boundary of the closed area (exclusion zone) will be monitored by NT Police on 24/7 basis. Port users must follow the directions of NT Police. Failure to follow these directions may result in removal from the area and/or arrest.</p> <p>The western boundary of the exclusion zone is 250m chainage mark along EAW (Point A), extending in a SSW direction to Point B, then SSE to point C, then ESE to Point D, before extending north to Point E. Please refer to the coordinates and map below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Point A - 12° 29'28" S. 130° 52'55" E</li><li>• Point B - 12° 29'31" S. 130° 52'53" E</li><li>• Point C - 12° 29'36" S. 130° 52'57" E</li><li>• Point D - 12° 29'38" S. 130° 52' 05" E</li><li>• Point E - 12°29'33" S. 130°53'06" E</li></ul> <p>Persons and vessels are required to keep clear of the closed waters for security reason</p>
