Crown Lands Act

Revocation of Proclamation and Constitution of
Town of Elliott

I, John Laurence Hardy, Administrator of the Northern Territory of Australia, acting with advice of the Executive Council:

- (a) under section 95(1) of the *Crown Lands Act* and with reference to section 108(2) of that Act and section 43 of the *Interpretation Act*, revoke the instrument dated 2 August 1950, as amended and in force immediately before the date of this instrument:
- (i) proclaiming the constitution of the Town of Elliott and defining the boundaries of that Town; and
 - (ii) published in the *Commonwealth of Australia Gazette* No. 46 dated 10 August 1950; and
- (b) under section 95(1) of the *Crown Lands Act*, constitute and define the boundaries of the Town of Elliott as described in Schedule 1 and shown outlined by the thick black line on the map in Schedule 2.

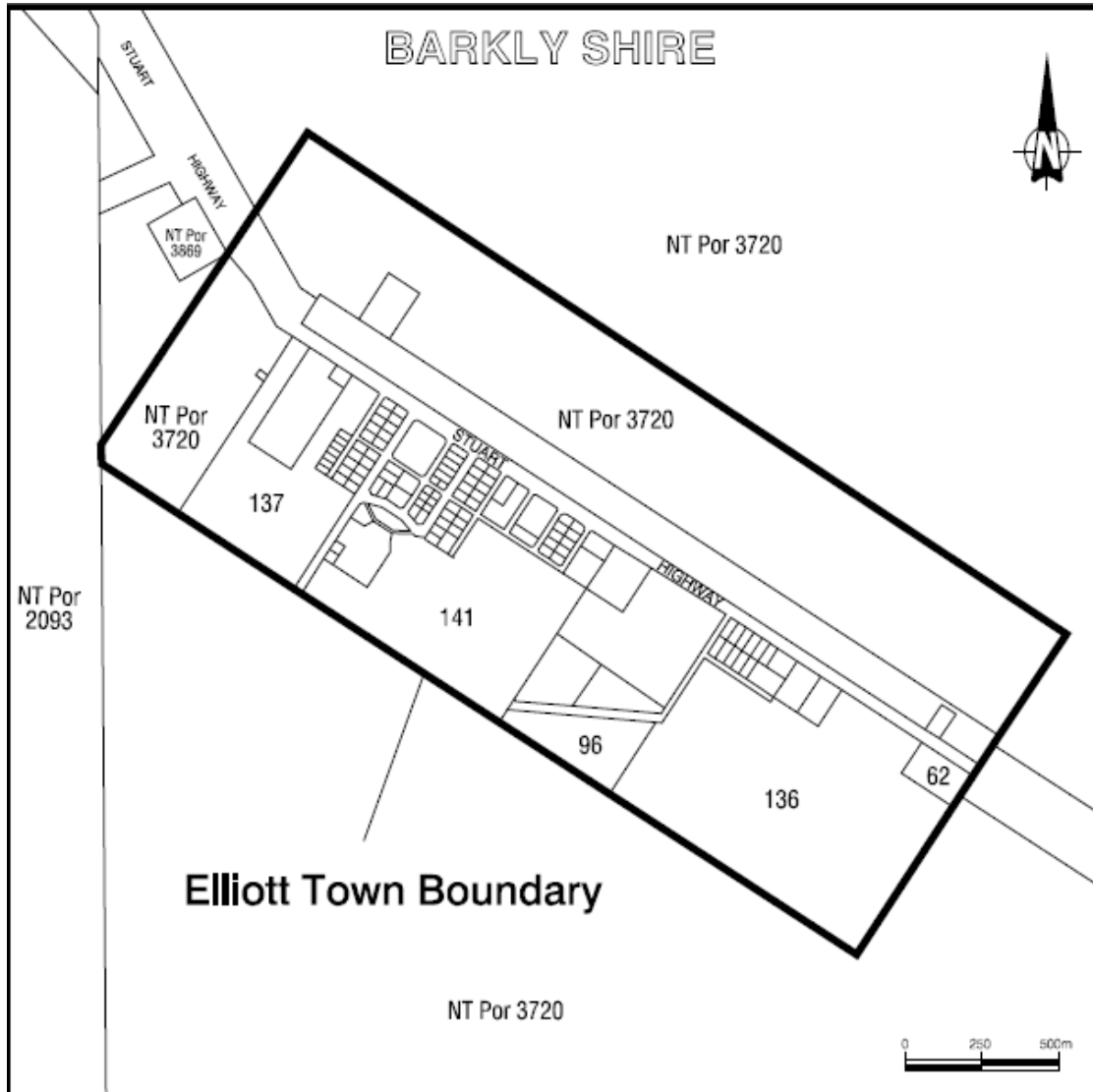

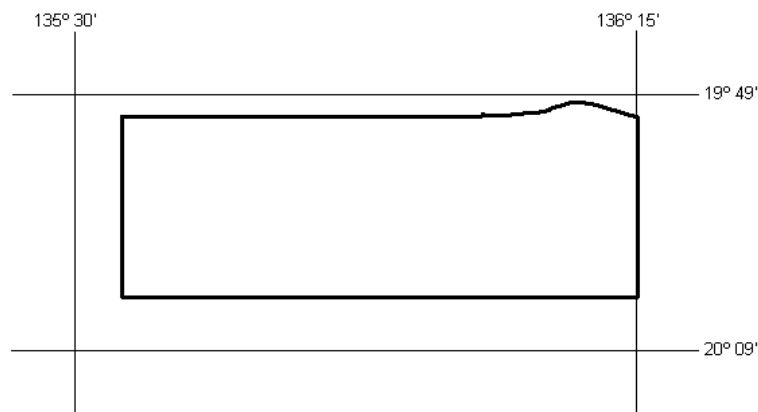
Revocation of Reservation of Blocks – RB59

Datum: The displayed grid defining the 5' x 5' blocks is AGD66 and coordinates shown are GDA94.

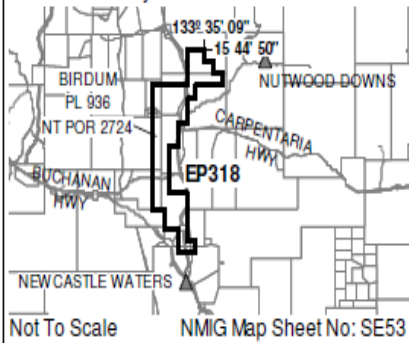
NOTICE OF PROPOSED GRANT OF EXPLORATION PERMIT (PETROLEUM)

PETROLEUM ACT (NT) SECTION 18
NATIVE TITLE ACT 1993 (CTH) SECTION 29

The Honourable David William Tollner MLA, the Northern Territory Minister for Mines and Energy, c/- Department of Mines and Energy, GPO Box 4550 DARWIN NT 0801, hereby gives notice in accordance with section 18 of the *Petroleum Act* (Northern Territory) and section 29 of the *Native Title Act* 1993 (Commonwealth) that application has been made for, and the Minister intends to grant, Exploration Permit (Petroleum) ("Permit") under Division 2 of Part II of the *Petroleum Act* (NT) as follows.

Application to which this notice applies:

Exploration Permit 318 sought by INPEX OIL AND GAS AUSTRALIA PTY LTD, ACN 155 960 151 over an area of 50 Blocks depicted below for a term of 5 years, within the NEWCASTLE WATERS locality.



Nature of act(s): The grant of a permit under the *Petroleum Act*, gives the person to whom it is granted the exclusive right, for a term of up to 5 years, to explore for petroleum and to carry on such operations and execute such works as are necessary for that purpose in the area covered by the permit including (but not limited to) use of machinery and equipment for carrying out works, removal of material for testing, use of water resources for domestic use and to seek renewals. A permit may be renewed no more than twice. If petroleum is discovered in a Permit area, production licences and/or retention licences may subsequently be granted. Further information about the act may be obtained from the Department of Mines and Energy GPO Box 4550 DARWIN NT 0801, or Centrepoint Building 48-50 Smith St Mall, DARWIN NT 0800.

Native Title Parties: Any person who is, or becomes a "native title party" within the meaning of the *Native Title Act* is entitled to the negotiation and/or procedural rights provided in Part 2, Division 3, Subdivision P of the *Native Title Act*. Under section 30 of the *Native Title Act*, persons have until 3 months after the notification day to take certain steps to become native title parties in relation to this notice. Objections under Section 19 of the *Petroleum Act*: Pursuant to section 19 of the *Petroleum Act*, a person who has an estate or interest in relation to land comprised in, or land contiguous with land comprised in, an area covered by the proposed grant may, within two (2) months after the notification day, lodge in writing an objection to the proposed grant. Such objection may be lodged at the Office of the Minister for Mines and Energy, c/- Department of Mines and Energy, Centrepoint Building, 48-50 Smith Street Mall, DARWIN NT 0800 or GPO Box 4550 DARWIN NT 0801.

Notification Day: For the purposes of section 29(4) of the *Native Title Act*, the notification day is 25 February 2015.
