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Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act

APPROVAL TO POSSESS AND SUPPLY
SCHEDULED SUBSTANCES

I, STEVEN JAYE SKOV, Acting Chief Health Officer:

- (a) under section 29(4A) of the Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act and with reference to section 43 of the Interpretation Act, revoke all approvals to possess and supply Scheduled substances under section 29(4A) of the Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act that are in force immediately before the date of this instrument; and
(b) under section 29(4A) of the Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act and with reference to section 42 of the Interpretation Act, approve each registered nurse employed and performing duties at premises listed in Appendix A to possess and supply a Schedule 2, 3 or 4 substance, subject to the following conditions:
(c) a substance listed in Appendix B may only be supplied:
(i) by administering it in the manner specified for the substance in Appendix B; and
(ii) with the personal attendance or advice of a medical practitioner, unless the registered nurse is satisfied on reasonable grounds that the medical condition of the person to whom the substance is to be administered requires its administration without delay; and

- (d) a substance listed in Appendix C may only be supplied by administering it in the manner specified for the substance in Appendix C; and
(e) a substance listed in Appendix D may only be supplied in accordance with the Scheduled substance treatment protocol for the substance; and
(f) a substance that is not listed in Appendix B, C or D may only be supplied under the direction or supervision of a medical practitioner.
