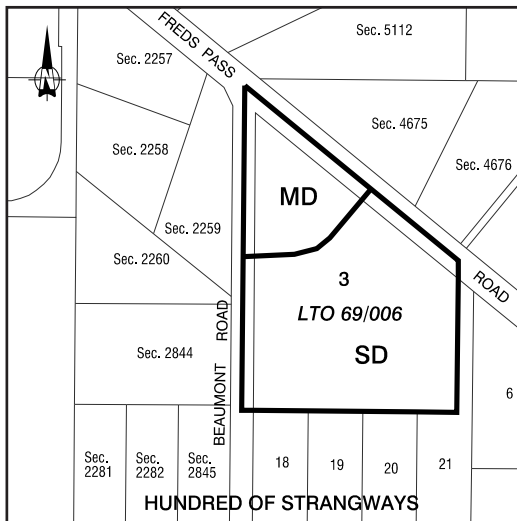

NORTHERN TERRITORY ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION AUTHORITY

NORTHERN TERRITORY WASTE MANAGEMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE - TERMS OF REFERENCE

Section 25 of the *Northern Territory Environment Protection Authority Act* provides that the Northern Territory Environment Protection Authority (NT EPA) must, at the request of the Minister, advise the Minister of certain matters set out in the *Act* including achieving appropriate and effective environmental policy and management for the Northern Territory and regarding legislation related to the environment and its administration.

Pursuant to Section 25(1)(a) of the *Northern Territory Environment Protection Authority Act*, the Minister has requested the NT EPA provide advice on the following:

- 1 Matters impacting effective and efficient waste management in the Northern Territory including:
 - Consideration of remote and regional concerns;
 - Approaches for increasing resource recovery; and
 - National obligations.
- 2 Opportunities to improve waste management outcomes for the Northern Territory; and
- 3 Options and recommendations on how the Northern Territory Government should respond to the identified matters and opportunities.

Section 11 of the *Waste Management and Pollution Control Act* enables the NT EPA to establish a consultative Committee as the NT EPA sees fit to provide information or conduct research as specified in a *Gazette* notice. To provide the requested advice, the NT EPA will form the Waste Management Advisory Committee to provide input into the development of a Northern Territory Waste Management Strategy (NT WMS).

The Committee will ensure the NT EPA is well informed and responsive to the Northern Territory's waste management needs. The objective is to identify opportunities for improving waste management practices in the Northern Territory. The Committee will remain open from January 2014 to 31 March 2015.

Preliminary advice including issues regarding waste management in the Northern Territory will be provided to the Minister for Lands, Planning and the Environment by 30 June 2014. Final advice will be provided by 31 December 2014.
