Lodge this return within 14 days of the end of the fiscal year with the Geoscience InfoCentre, Northern Territory Geological Survey.

## Mineral Production Return – Financial Year 2017/2018

Commodity	Types Covered
<b>Alumina</b>	Use for all types including alumina hydrate (as equivalent alumina).
<b>Bauxite</b>	Use for all types of bauxite.
<b>Copper Concentrate</b>	Use where the commodity produced and sold is a concentrate. Do not report the minerals that make-up the concentrate as separate commodities.
<b>Diamonds</b>	Use for diamonds.
<b>Gemstones</b>	Use for all types of gemstones.
<b>Gold</b>	Use for all types of pure gold including gold nuggets.
<b>Gold Dore</b>	Report the gold and silver metal in gold dore as a metallic content % and not as separate gold and silver commodities.
<b>Iron Ore</b>	Use for all types of iron ore including magnetite.
<b>Iron Ore Concentrate</b>	Use where the commodity produced and sold is a concentrate. Do not report the minerals that make-up the concentrate as separate commodities.
<b>Lead Concentrate</b>	Use where the commodity produced and sold is a concentrate. Do not report the minerals that make-up the concentrate as separate commodities.
<b>Limestone</b>	Use for limestone.
<b>Manganese</b>	Use for all types of manganese. This includes fines, lump and intermediate.
<b>Mineral Sands Concentrate</b>	Use where the commodity produced and sold is a concentrate. The minerals that make-up the concentrate should not be reported as separate commodities. It is optional to report the metallic content % of the concentrate.
<b>Phosphate</b>	Use for all types of phosphorite.
<b>Quicklime</b>	Use for quicklime.
<b>Salt</b>	Use for all types of salt whether lake, evaporative or rock salt including potash.
<b>Silver</b>	Use for all types of pure silver.
<b>Tantalite</b>	Use for all types of tantalite.
<b>Tin</b>	Use for all types of tin.
<b>Tin/Tantalite Concentrate</b>	Use where the commodity produced and sold is a concentrate. Do not report the minerals that make-up the concentrate as separate commodities. It is optional to report the metallic content % of the concentrate.
<b>Uranium</b>	Use for all types of uranium including uranium oxide.
<b>Vermiculite</b>	Use for all types of vermiculite.
<b>Zinc Concentrate</b>	Use where the commodity produced and sold is a concentrate. Do not report the minerals that make-up the concentrate as separate commodities.
<b>Zinc/Lead Concentrate</b>	Use where the commodity produced and sold is a concentrate. The metal in the concentrate must be reported as the metallic content % of lead and zinc.
