Description of Activity:	<p>A Dive Team will be carrying out protective works along a submarine cable between the location of the Mandorah Queen wreck and Mandorah Beach</p> <p>The dive vessel 'Spoonbill' will display flag Alpha when divers are in the water, vessels are requested to keep 60 metres from the vessel when the Alpha Flag is displayed</p> <p>A yellow special marker with flashing yellow light will be secured to the cable on the seabed to mark the progress of cable protection. This special marker will move along the route daily.</p> <p>Dive team will notify harbour control daily on the special marker's location.</p>
