#### 1. Citation

This amendment to the NT Planning Scheme 2020 may be cited as Amendment No. 77.

2. Amend Schedule 3: exceptions

After

Subclause 3(w) in Schedule 3

Insert

3(x) Mobile food and drink premises, including where **ancillary** to **sport and recreation**, that operate on public land or a road reserve controlled by a government agency or local government council, provided that approval has been obtained from the controlling agency for the land.

#### Reasons for Decision

# NORTHERN TERRITORY PLANNING SCHEME 2020 Amendment No. 77

Amendment 77 inserts subclause 3(x) to Schedule 3 "Exceptions". The introduction of this subclause means that mobile food and drink premises that operate on public land or a road reserve controlled by a Government agency or Local Government Council are exempt from the NT Planning Scheme 2020, provided that approval has been obtained from the controlling agency for the land.

I approved this amendment without public exhibition because:

- the exception facilitates a continuation of existing processes for regulating mobile food and drink premises; and
- in instances where the exception applies it remains subject to compliance and approval from controlling Government agencies.
