

Approved identification devices for livestock in the NT

In the Northern Territory permanent identification devices and tags must be approved for attachment to livestock under Section 16(1) of the *Livestock Act* and Section 37 of the *Livestock Regulations*.

The following devices are approved for use on livestock in the Northern Territory.
