Public and Environmental Health Act 2011

Appointment of Chief Health Officer and Appointment of Acting Chief Health Officers

I, Natasha Kate Fyles, Minister for Health:

- (a) under section 67(1) of the *Public and Environmental Health Act 2011* (the **Act**), appoint Christine Maree Connors to be the Chief Health Officer; and
- (b) under section 67(1) of the Act and with reference to section 44(1) of the *Interpretation Act 1978*, terminate all appointments of persons to act in the Office of Chief Health Officer in force immediately before the date this instrument is published in the *Gazette*; and
- (c) under section 67(1) of the Act and with reference to section 44A of the *Interpretation Act 1978*, appoint each person named in the Schedule to act in the office of Chief Health Officer:
 - (i) during the period specified opposite the person; and

- (ii) when no other person has been appointed to act in the office of Chief Health Officer during the particular period of vacancy or inability to perform the duties of the office.

Person	Period
Danielle Marie Esler	All periods when there is a vacancy in the office of Chief Health Officer or the person appointed to the office is unable to perform the duties of the office.
Christopher Paul Burgess	All periods when: (a) there is a vacancy in the office of Chief Health Officer or the person appointed to the office is unable to perform the duties of the office; and (b) Danielle Marie Esler is unable, for any reason, to perform the duties of the office.
Victoria Lynn Krause	All periods when: (a) there is a vacancy in the office of Chief Health Officer or the person appointed to the office is unable to perform the duties of the office; and (b) the following persons are unable, for any reason, to perform the duties of the office: (i) Danielle Marie Esler; (ii) Christopher Paul Burgess.
