- (a) under section 5A(1) and(2) of the *Commercial Passenger (Road) Transport Act 1991* (the **Act**) and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act 1978*, revoke the directions given by the instrument entitled 'Public Interest Ministerial Direction', dated 24 August 2022; and
- (b) under section 5A(1) and (2) of the Act, give the Director the directions set out in Schedules 1 and 2.

**Schedule 1     Directions for controlling number of taxi licences in Alice Springs taxi area**

1     In this Schedule:

***Alice Springs taxi area*** means the area specified as such in a declaration as in force from time to time under section 16 of the Act.

***controlled period*** means the period beginning on the date of this instrument and ending on the earlier of the following:

- (a) 30 June 2027;
- (b) the date of the revocation of the directions in this Schedule.

2     The directions in this Schedule:

- (a) apply in relation to the exercise of the Director's powers and performance of the Director's functions under section 18 of the Act to grant taxi licences; and

- (b) limit the number of taxi licences to operate a taxi within the Alice Springs taxi area that may be granted by the Director during the controlled period for the purpose of controlling in the public interest the number of taxi licences in force in the Alice Springs taxi area.
- 3 To avoid doubt, the directions in this Schedule do not limit:
  - (a) the grant under section 18 of the Act of any taxi licence to operate a taxi within any taxi area other than the Alice Springs taxi area; and
  - (b) the renewal under section 23A of the Act of any taxi licence to operate a taxi within the Alice Springs taxi area during the controlled period.
- 4 No more than 6 taxi licences to operate a taxi within the Alice Springs taxi area (the ***new taxi licences***) may be granted by the Director during the controlled period.
- 5 During the controlled period, the Director:
  - (a) must conduct a ballot draw for the purposes of determining the manner in which the new taxi licences are to be allocated amongst any applicants for the licences; and
  - (b) may only grant the new taxi licences to applicants who participate in the ballot draw conducted by the Director and are allocated one of the new licences in accordance with it.
- 6 The ballot draw referred to in clause 5 is to be conducted in accordance with the processes and requirements set out in the document prepared by the Department of Logistics and Infrastructure and entitled '2026 Alice Springs and Darwin Taxi Licence Ballots'.
- 7 Despite clauses 4 and 5, at any time during the controlled period the Director may grant an applicant a taxi licence to operate a taxi within the Alice Springs taxi area in the circumstances specified in clause 8 or 9.

- 8 For clause 7, a taxi licence to operate a taxi within the Alice Springs taxi area may be granted to an applicant if:
- (a) the applicant previously held a taxi licence to operate a taxi within the Alice Springs taxi area (the **former licence**) that expired; and
  - (b) the applicant did not make an application under section 23A(1) of the Act for the renewal of the former licence; and
  - (c) the Director is satisfied that the applicant had a reasonable excuse for failing to make an application to renew the former licence; and
  - (d) the application for the taxi licence is made by the applicant within 12 months of the expiry of the former licence.
- 9 For clause 7, a taxi licence to operate a taxi within the Alice Springs taxi area may be granted to an applicant if:
- (a) the applicant is a close family member of a holder of a taxi licence to operate a taxi within the Alice Springs taxi area who has died; and
  - (b) the taxi licence to be granted to the applicant is to replace the licence of the deceased holder mentioned in paragraph (a).

**Schedule 2 Directions for controlling number of taxi licences in Darwin taxi area**

- 1 In this Schedule:
- Darwin taxi area** means the area specified as such in a declaration as in force from time to time under section 16 of the Act.
- controlled period** means the period beginning on the date of this instrument and ending on the earlier of the following:
- (a) 30 June 2027;
  - (b) the date of the revocation of the directions in this Schedule.
- 2 The directions in this Schedule:
- (a) apply in relation to the exercise of the Director's powers and performance of the Director's functions under section 18 of the Act to grant taxi licences; and

- (b) restrict the granting of additional taxi licences to operate a taxi within the Darwin taxi area during the controlled period for the purpose of controlling in the public interest the number of taxi licences in force in the Darwin taxi area.
- 3 To avoid doubt, the directions in this Schedule do not limit:
  - (a) the grant under section 18 of the Act of any taxi licence to operate a taxi within any taxi area other than the Darwin taxi area; and
  - (b) the renewal under section 23A of the Act of any taxi licence to operate a taxi within the Darwin taxi area during the controlled period.
- 4 No taxi licences to operate a taxi within the Darwin taxi area may be granted by the Director during the controlled period.
- 5 Despite clause 4, at any time during the controlled period the Director may grant an applicant a taxi licence to operate a taxi within the Darwin taxi area in the circumstances specified in clause 6 or 7.
- 6 For clause 5, a taxi licence to operate a taxi within the Darwin taxi area may be granted to an applicant if:
  - (a) the applicant previously held a taxi licence to operate a taxi within the Darwin taxi area (the **former licence**) that expired; and
  - (b) the applicant did not make an application under section 23A(1) of the Act for the renewal of the former licence; and
  - (c) the Director is satisfied that the applicant had a reasonable excuse for failing to make an application to renew the former licence; and
  - (d) the application for the taxi licence is made by the applicant within 12 months of the expiry of the former licence.
- 7 For clause 5, a taxi licence to operate a taxi within the Darwin taxi area may be granted to an applicant if:
  - (a) the applicant is a close family member of a holder of a taxi licence to operate a taxi within the Darwin taxi area who has died; and

- (b) the taxi licence to be granted to the applicant is to replace the licence of the deceased holder mentioned in paragraph (a).

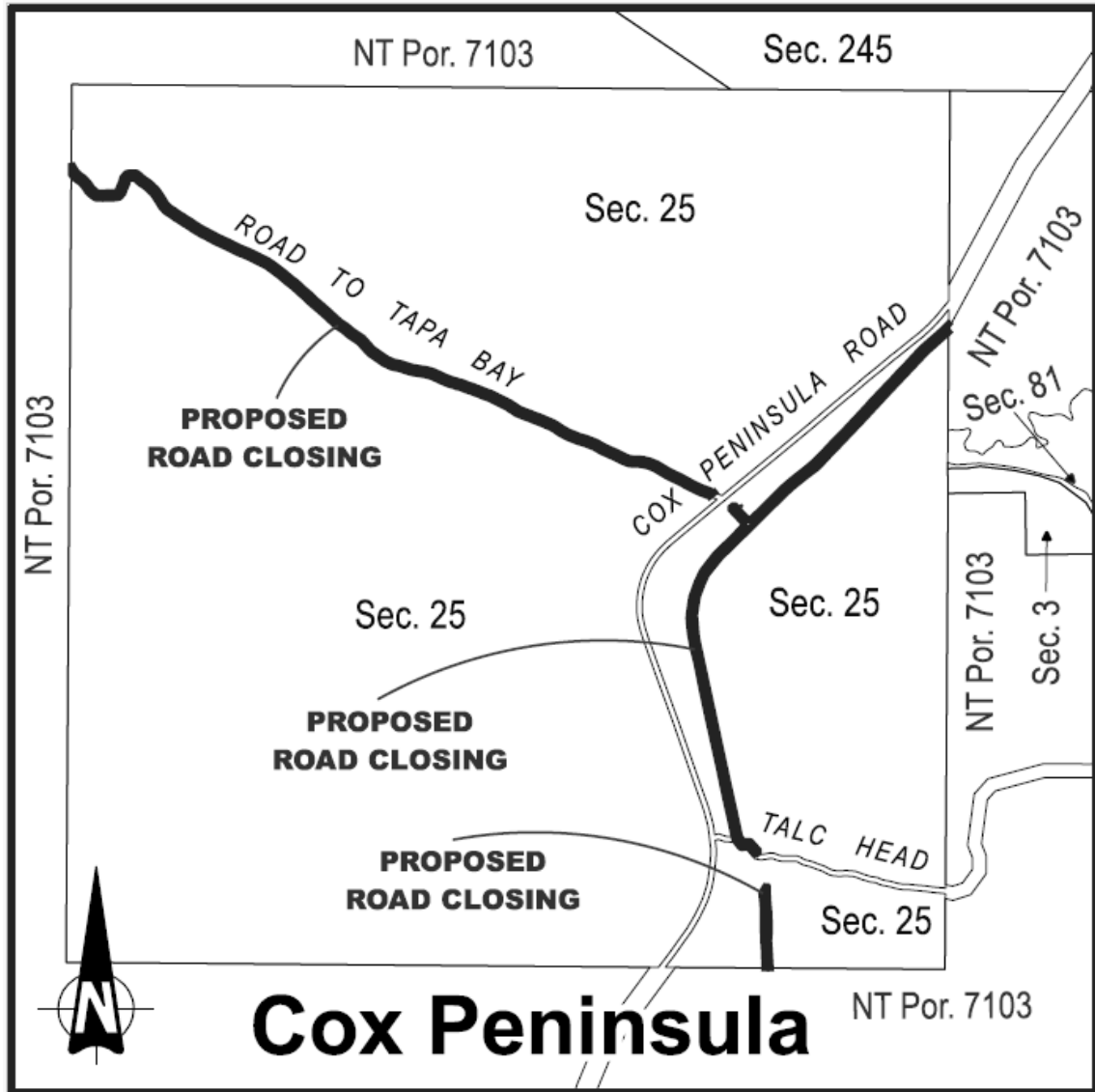
