Private Security Act 1995

**Approval of Competency Standards and Training:
Crowd Controllers and Security Officers**

I, Natasha Kate Fyles, Minister for Racing, Gaming and Licensing;

- (a) under section 53(1) of the *Private Security Act 1995*, and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act 1978*, revoke all approvals of competency standards and training in respect of the crowd controller and security officer licence categories; and
- (b) under section 53(1) of the *Private Security Act 1995*, approve the competency standards and training specified in the Schedule as the competency standards, and training required to attain the competency standards, in respect of crowd controller and security officer licence categories.

Schedule

- (1) For a crowd controller licence, an applicant must be certified by a registered training organisation as competent in:
 - (a) the 14 units of competency constituting the CPP20218 Certificate II in Security Operations including a current HLTAID011 or HLTAID003 Provide first aid unit; or
 - (b) the following 12 units of competency:
 - (i) CPPSEC2001A Communicate effectively in the security industry;
 - (ii) CPPSEC2002A Follow workplace safety procedures in the security industry;
 - (iii) CPPSEC2003B Work effectively in the security industry;
 - (iv) CPPSEC2004B Respond to security risk situation;
 - (v) CPPSEC2005A Work as part of a security team;
 - (vi) CPPSEC2006B Provide security services to clients;
 - (vii) CPPSEC2009A Give evidence in court;
 - (viii) CPPSEC2011B Control access to and exit from premises;
 - (ix) CPPSEC2012A Monitor and control individual and crowd behaviour;
 - (x) CPPSEC2014A Operate basic security equipment;
 - (xi) CPPSEC2017A Protect self and others using basic defensive tactics;
 - (xii) current HLTAID011 or HLTAID003 Provide first aid.
- (2) For a security officer licence, an applicant must be certified by a registered training organisation as competent in:
 - (a) the 14 units of competency constituting the CPP20218 Certificate II in Security Operations including a current HLTAID011 or HLTAID003 Provide first aid unit; or

- (b) the following 13 units of competency:
- (i) CPPSEC2001A Communicate effectively in the security industry;
 - (ii) CPPSEC2002A Follow workplace safety procedures in the security industry;
 - (iii) CPPSEC2003B Work effectively in the security industry;
 - (iv) CPPSEC2004B Respond to security risk situation;
 - (v) CPPSEC2005A Work as part of a security team;
 - (vi) CPPSEC2006B Provide security services to clients;
 - (vii) CPPSEC2007A Screen people;
 - (viii) CPPSEC2008A Screen items;
 - (ix) CPPSEC2009A Give evidence in court;
 - (x) CPPSEC2013A Protect valuables in transit;
 - (xi) CPPSEC2014A Operate basic security equipment;
 - (xii) CPPSEC2015A Patrol premises;
 - (xiii) current HLTAID011 or HLTAID003 Provide first aid.
- (3) In this Schedule, a reference to a unit of competency includes a reference to a unit which is equivalent to that unit.
