In accordance with regulation 51, 51C and 51D of the Livestock Regulations 2009

Complete this form when you transfer the ownership of beehives within Northern Territory (NT). You are required to notify the Bee Registrar of your transfer within 7 days.

If the transfer is to a new owner, the new owner must complete a beehive registration form via the NT Government (NTG) website¹, and notify the Registrar of the transfer within 28 days of the transfer occurring.

A full general health inspection and report of the hive/s, by both parties should be conducted prior to the transfer and movement of the hive/s via the NTG website² and can be submitted with this notification.
