

# R31 Apply to transfer the right to display number plates

## Before you start:

- You must be a Motor Vehicle Registry (MVR) customer, otherwise, evidence of identity and residency documents are required.
- A person acting on behalf of the applicant(s) must provide a letter of authority from the current/new number plate holder.
- You must surrender the number plates to MVR if you are not intending to fit the number plates on an NT registered vehicle at the time of this application.
- Surrendered number plates are kept at MVR for 12 months, until the holder is ready to attached them to a registered vehicle in their name.

**Important:** Plates unattached after 12 months will be disposed of.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All number plates remain the property of the Registrar of Motor Vehicles. As a plate holder, you are paying a fee for the 'Right to Display' <b>only</b>, and not for purchase of the number plates.</li> <li>The number plates <b>must</b> be fitted to an NT registered vehicle within 12 months, or your 'Right to Display' will expire and made available to the general public to order.</li> <li>For vehicles left unregistered, you will retain the 'Right to Display' for 12 months. Immediately after 12 months, your 'Right to Display' will expire and made available to the general public to order.</li> </ul> <p>You may extend the hold period of your surrendered number plates for 12 months at a time (up to 24 months). Plate extend hold requests can only be processed 6 weeks before the expiry date of the 'Right to Display'. Plate extend hold fees will be charged per 12 months.</p>
