<b>Summary instrument</b>			
<p>A summary instrument may be lodged if the dealing contains commercially sensitive information. The details to be included in the summary instrument should be the same as those listed under regulation 4 of the Petroleum (Submerged Lands) Regulations 1981.</p>			
<b>Before submitting your application</b>			
<p>Familiarise yourself with sections 81-86 and sections 91-92 of the <i>Petroleum (Submerged Lands) Act 1981</i>. A dealing is of no force or effect until the instrument has been approved by the Minister and an entry of the approval of the instrument has been made in the register.</p>			
<b>Fees</b>			
<p>A dealing fee applies for each title and will be calculated on lodgement. Refer to the current fee schedule available from the <a href="#">NT Government website</a><sup>i</sup>. An invoice will be raised on request. Invoices are payable by BPAY, credit card (online and phone), cheque, direct credit and in person at the Department of Corporate and Digital Development.</p>
