PLUMBING PRODUCT CERTIFICATION AND COMPLIANCE

Building Practitioners, including Certifying Plumbers, are reminded that compliance is required when certifying plumbing installations and products.

The Northern Territory Government regulations require that all plumbing installations comply with AS/NZ:3500 'The Plumbing Code', which in turns requires that plumbing products are authorised in line with SAA MP52 'The Manual for Authorisation of Plumbing and Drainage Products'.

The integrity of water quality and the maintenance of public health and safety are paramount.

The authorisation is demonstrated by marking the product with the Standards Mark or the Water Mark.

Only marked taps and brassware products should be purchased and installed. If there is no mark the plumber may be personally liable.

All taps, pipes and fittings should have a standards mark or watermark.

There are only two marks to identify:
