1. NT drivers licence with an "H" endorsement.
2. Appropriate vessel survey certification.
3. Appropriate Marine qualifications.
4. \$10 million minimum third party liability insurance.
5. Senior First Aid certificate.

Proof of identity Individual person – photographic identification; ie. Driver's licence or passport.

Corporation - Certificate of Incorporation.

Company - Current Company Search available form Australian Security Commission.
