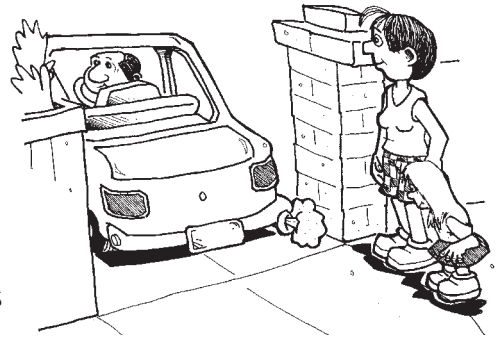




Walk and talk
