

# Owners permission to use run on ALT Livestock Act

To operate on an Aboriginal Land Trust (ALT) Applicants must first discuss their proposal with either the Northern Land Council (NLC) or Central Land Council (CLC) or Indigenous Land and Sea Corporation (ILSC)

These Land Councils act as a body corporate established pursuant to, and has statutory functions under, the Commonwealth *Aboriginal Land Rights (Northern Territory) Act 1976* and provide administrative support to the Land Trust.

Applicants are required to enter into a legal agreement with the Land Council / ILSC and ALT, for example a Section 19 *Land Use Agreement, Mustering Agreement, Lease, Grazing Licence* and/or etc.

Once a Section 19 is approved and processed by the Land Council, Applicant/s can submit paperwork relating to Brands.
